#### PROVINCIALS REPORT – NOVEMBER 30 – DECEMBER 3, 2023

The 2023 Golden Gals Provincials were held at Virden Curling Club with sixteen teams representing the twelve districts. Teams included Lorna Rice and Debbie McNeill from District 1, Norma Johnson, Lois Rozak and Leanne Fedak from District 2 (Fedak Team filled the spot to be represented by District 10 which was unfilled), Linda Newton and Sandra Cowling from District 3/5, Joyce McDougall from District 4/6, Bev Atkins from District 7, Arlene Deprez from District 8, Lori Pelissier, Beth McLeod, and Bev Haas from District 9, Marian Whalen from District 11, Kathy Isaac from District 12 with Florence Klassen team representing the Host.

Lynda Draper of Virden had initiated plans for the 40<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Golden Gals Curling, however, unexpectedly passed away in June. Kathy Cox, President and Linda Wilson, Secretary-Treasurer took over the planning duties. Kathy organized all entertainment and decorating keeping the 40<sup>th</sup> anniversary theme prevalent and emceed all activities over the weekend. Linda canvassed businesses in Virden and cash donations and items for the Raffle were graciously received. All teams also donated raffle items. Marilyn Warkentin. Shannon Kinnaird, Jeanette Logan, Linda Newton, Karen McKinnon all assisted with various duties during the weekend. Geordie Barkley attended to ice duties while Thelma Quinn provided the luncheon and other catering duties, and Darla Hayward opened the Bar for the ladies. The Provincials would not have been successful without this assistance. Not having to pay ice rental greatly improved our cash-flow situation and a thank you

was sent to Virden Curling Club. Income totalled \$2,935.00 and expenses amounted to \$1,933.14 resulting in a profit of \$1,001.86 which funds have been deposited to the Golden Gals account.

#### **ANNUAL MEETING MINUTES**

The annual meeting of the Golden Gals Curling Association was held Tuesday, May 9, 2023 at Seniors for Seniors Club, Brandon, Manitoba with registration of 10 members. President Kathy Cox welcomed all to the meeting. Kathy called the meeting to order, and it was noted that Olive McLenehan of Virden had passed away. A moment of silence was observed remembering the deceased. Roll Call answered by attendees from District 1 - 0; District 2 - 4; District 3/5 - 4; District 4/6 - 0; District 7 - 0, District 8 - 0; District 9 - 0 and Districts 10, 11 & 12 - 2 for a total of 10 members.

Minutes of the last annual meeting have been entered on the website and it was Moved by Linda Wilson, Seconded by Marian Whalen that the minutes of the meeting of September 6 2022 be approved. Carried Business Arising: None

Treasurer's Report: Linda Wilson reported a balance of \$1,244.43 in the chequing account and GICs totaling \$10,652.85 for a grand total of \$11,897.28. Moved by Linda Wilson, Seconded by Marilyn Warkentin that the Treasurer's Report be accepted as presented for information purposes.

Ways & Means – Reported in annual report. Districts are reminded that this is the only fundraiser undertaken by Golden Gals.

Charms & Trophies – Reported in annual report.

Ice & Draw: Reported in annual report. Lynda Draper once again attended to the draw which included 12 teams in 2022.

Provincial Bonspiel: Reported in annual report. All teams who attended reported a good bonspiel and exceptional hospitality from the Flin Flon Curling Club.

**New Business:** 

- 1) 2023 Provincials: Virden Curling Club has offered to host the 2023 Golden Gals Provincials on November 30 December 3, 2023. Lynda Draper reported that there will be no charge from the Virden Curling Club for ice rental, ice caretakers, bar nor canteen rentals if the Golden Gals Curling Association will attend to organization of the Provincials. Lynda Draper and Linda Wilson will plan the Provincials. Lynda reported she has secured four volunteers to attend to selling of raffle tickets and assisting with registration details. Details regarding available accommodation will be available at the Fall semi-annual meeting. Bar and Caterer have been booked. Lynda has been working on decorations and entertainment.
- District Playdowns: It was decided to keep the current format of District Playdowns. The information will be provided to District Chairpersons at the September meeting. Dates and locations of district playdowns will be discussed at that meeting. It was decided that the districts would be able to enter teams as follows: District 1-2, District 2-2, District 3/5-2; District 4/6-1, District 7-1, District 8-1, District 9-3, District 10/11/12-3 and Host 1.
- 3) 40<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Celebrations: A celebration of 40 years of curling will be held in conjunction with the Golden Gals Provincials in Virden. The format to be followed was discussed. It was decided registrations, practices, briefing and photos would take place Thursday, November 30<sup>th</sup> shortly after 3:00 p.m. There would

be one draw Thursday evening to allow ample time on Friday, December 1<sup>st</sup> to have a luncheon with the official opening and celebrations from 11:00 – 2:00 p.m. There would be three draws on Friday with three draws Saturday and the finals on Sunday. Curlers and 40<sup>th</sup> anniversary celebrants would be invited to attend the luncheon at a nominal cost of \$10.00 per person. Each District Chairperson will be responsible for contacting all known former curlers in their area to inform her of the 40<sup>th</sup> anniversary and if she is not aware of all former curlers from the various curling clubs, she should contact someone from those curling clubs to ensure that all former Golden Gals curlers are invited to the celebration. The members at the meeting agreed that those expressing an interest in attending should be made known to Linda Wilson by September 1<sup>st</sup> and a definite confirmation of attendance would need to be known by November 1<sup>st</sup> to confirm numbers attending and finalize planning. President, Kathy Cox will emcee the event.

- 4) Kathy reminded all Golden Gals curlers that our organization is still without a vice-president.
- 5) Future of Golden Gals: Positive comments were expressed by those attending Flin Flon Provincials and Linda and Kathy have received positive feedback that Golden Gals Curling should continue.
